ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This competition is an Invitational competition which means this competition is accessible for every gymnast to be able to attend and enjoy AcroPad equipment. As the IGA Handbook's the requirements in regards to the Coaches and Gymnast responsibilities still stand and must be adhered to at all times. We will also be entering the gymnasts in the new age groups, and this competition will be available to WAG/MAG and GFA.

COMPETITION STRUCTURE

Our Acro Pad competition will feature three thrilling pieces: Floor, Tumble, and Trampette. Gymnasts can choose which pieces they want to compete in, with each entry costing £10.00 per piece at our standard rate. Regardless of how many pieces they enter, gymnasts must compete at the same level, as per IGA competition structure.

For those entering all three pieces, there's an exciting opportunity to compete for the overall award and 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awardedfor each category on each piece of apparatus! Please be aware that Invitational awards differ from the usual IGA structures, Individual competitors woithin a category will only be eligible for the overall award.

HOW TO ENTER

IGA registered clubs can enter their gymnasts through our portal as standard. Non-IGA registered clubs, can still enter but will need to provide the following:

- Complete our entry form and submit to competitions@igauk.com [Email the team for the entry form].
- IGA will invoice you directly with a small fee added to cover the cost of your insurance for the day.
- Coaches must be added to the entry form and provide copies of their DBS and qualifications to safeguard the participants.

Refunds for entry fee's are only made in the event of an injury, and a valid medical note must be provided as evidence. In all other cases, entry fee's are non-refundable. Please email our competition team your valid doctor's note. This refund can be used against any penalty fee's if the club has incurred one.





COMPETITION RULES:

This competition is open to all participants.

Floor

When entering your gymnasts on Floor they will be judged the same as the IGA Levels. Please use the Level rules as your guide. GFA will need to follow WAG Levels as we cannot have benches on the AcroPad Floor.

Tumble

Gymnasts will perform 2 out of the 3 Set Tumbles and score will be combined to give an overall score for this piece of apparatus. All tumbles can be performed from steps/run or jump.

Gymnasts will perform both and the scores will be added together to complete final score.
